The file `tcp06-abs.tex` should be downloaded and used to produce all abstracts submitted to the TCP'06 conference.

If you are using L^AT_EX 2_ε and you use the template unaltered, the abstract will automatically be formatted correctly. If you are using another wordprocessing package such as MS Word or WordPerfect, or a text editor, download and edit the file following the instructions below. Use this file `tcp06-inst.tex` as a guide for correct coding. If you are unable to use a wordprocessing package, please submit your abstract as plain ASCII text.

Enter the required fields between the braces `{}` of the commands listed below. *Please ensure that there are no spaces between the left brace and the entered text or between the entered text and the right brace.*

- Enter the title between the braces of the `\Title{}` command. If you need to include any lowercase letters, they must be inserted between the braces of the `\lowercase{}` command.
- A footnote to the title may be used to acknowledge financial support or other details. Enter the footnote text between the braces of the `\footnote{}` command.
- Enter the presenting author's name between the braces of the `\presentingauthor{}` command and the presenting author's e-mail address between the braces of the `\email{}` command.
- Additional authors at the same institution as the presenting author should be entered between the braces of the first `\otherauthor{}` command. In this case, the comma following the e-mail address should be left in the file.
- If there are no additional authors at the same institution as the presenting author, comment out the comma (by putting a `%` at the start of the line) and also comment out the first `\otherauthor{}` command.
- The presenting author's (and additional authors') institution should be entered between the braces of the first `\institution{}` command.
- Enter other authors, grouped by institution, using additional sets of `\otherauthor{}` `\institution{}` commands.
- Comment out or delete any unwanted sets of `\otherauthor{}` `\institution{}` code.
- Enter the text of the abstract at the end of the file before the `\end{document}` command.

(Note the `Enumerate`, `Itemize`, and `Description` environments provided for compressed vertical spacing.)

The abstract **must not exceed one page** and should fit within an area 165 mm (6.5 in.) wide and 203 mm (8 in.) high with a 25.4 mm (1 in.) left and 50.8 mm (2 in.) bottom margin. When using L^AT_EX 2_ε select the appropriate `\setlength{\topmargin}{}` command depending upon whether you are printing on US Letter or A4 paper.
